




INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS


Wall Installation

Zclip hangers



- 1. Measure out area on wall that will receive the panels to make sure of even and consistent layout top and bottom or where designated in specifications.
- 2. Note that a minimum 1" clearance at the panel top to allow install and removal, if needed, post install. It is recommended to have a z clip rail on wall every 4 linear ft of board minimum.
- 3. Before measuring and marking lines on wall, measure distance of screw holes of two z clips married.
- 4. Based on the height of the panels, install z clips on wall allowing for at least 1" from edge of board and gap between screw holes measured in step 2, for board installed clip.
- 5. Screw z clips on to board, adding glue to board where screw is installed on board and allow to dry.
- 6. Lift panel on to wall drop down for the panel clips and wall clips marry.

Construction Adhesive




- 1. Wall and board must be clean and free of debris and oil.
- 2. Loctite PL Premium or equivalent recommended.
- 3. Tube applied adhesive should frame the board 3" from edge and also a line from corner to corner creating an 'X'.
- 4. Spray adhesives can be used in combination with applied adhesives for immediate hold for tube/applied adhesive to dry.
- 5. It is recommended to use a brace to keep boards in place while adhesive dries.






INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

2-prong impaler



Wall Installation

- 1. Measure locations on wall for board placement to make sure 2-prong impalers are at least 2" from board edge.
- 2. Use drywall or flathead screw to insure a solid board placement once installed.
- 3. Once 2 prong impaler is screwed in place, add a drop of adhesive on the impaler. Once the board is installed, this will chemically adhere the board to the impaler and not the wall allowing easier removal if needed at a future time.
- 4. Push boards on to the impaler
- 5.(4) 2-prong impalers are needed for a 2'x4' board.





Temporary Wall Installation

Temporary install can easily be done by adding picture frame hangers.


- 1. Measure locations on the board for even placement.
- 2. Screw hangers on board with adhesive.
- 3. Measure and mark on wall locations for screws for hangers to rest.
- 4. Install screws on wall.
- 5. Hang panel on wall.



Ceiling Installation

Magnet Installation

- 1. Measure locations on ceiling to insure boards would fit without interruption from piping, conduit etc.
- 2. Measure suitable locations on ceiling where magnet can attach to metal ceiling, mark on corresponding locations on board.
- 3. Apply small dot of adhesive, (Gorilla Glue brand recommended) on each dot.
- 4. Attached magnet on board allowing the screw to penetrate the dot of adhesive.
- 5. Once adhesive is dry, overnight, raise board to ceiling for magnets to grab hold of the metal ceiling.



Pin & Cap Installation

- 1. Measure locations on ceiling to insure boards would fit without interruption from piping, conduit etc.
- 2. Glue impaling pin base to ceiling and allow to dry
- 3. Push boards on to the impaling pins making sure hands are not underneath.
- 4. Once board is in place, lightly press dome caps on tips on pins. Once positioned, dome caps will lock into place and hold the board in place.
